



## SCRIP Dress Down Day Q & A

Q: What is SCRIP?

A: Gift cards purchased through St. Edmond at face value for local and national retailers. Each business gives a percentage back. One half goes to the participant's tuition, and the other half to SE.

Q: How will the Dress Down Day (DDD) work?

A: Each family will place **ONE**, SCRIP order minimum of \$10. Send the order to school with your child/children the morning of the DDD.

Example: If you have multiple children attending SE you only need to place **ONE** minimum order of \$10 for the entire family.

Q: How will the students turn in the orders?

A: The children must bring the order to the **ELEMENTARY GYM** the morning of the DDD. Each child will receive a **DRESS DOWN PASS** that they must turn into their homeroom or first period teacher.

Q: What do the teachers do with the passes?

A: The teachers will collect and put all passes in the envelope provided. Teachers will place envelopes in the Business Office mailbox.

Q: What if I have children spread throughout the school and arrive at different times?

A: One child has to turn in the order for the family, but each child must come to the elementary gym to receive their own pass that they must turn into their own teacher.

Q: Who is eligible to participate?

A: Students in grades K-12, teachers, and staff.

Q: How early can an order be turned in?

A: We will be receiving orders from 7:30 a.m. to 8:10 a.m. in the **ELEMENTARY GYM.**

Q: Can I bring my SCRIP order in a few days early to count towards the DDD and receive a pass?

A: No, it must be the morning of DDD or any online orders need to be placed the day before up to 7:15 a.m. of DDD.

Q: What are the green, plastic envelopes used for?

A: Each family will receive an envelope with an order form. It is an easy way to transport the orders to and from school.

Q: When will I receive my SCRIP order?

A: All orders will be filled and sent home with your student by Friday of the same week.

Q: What if I have never used SCRIP before?

A: New SCRIP users need to fill out the waiver form provided in the green envelope and send back to school with your first order.

Q: Do online orders count for the DDD?

A: Online orders placed the day before up to 7:15 am on Monday will count for a DDD pass.

Q: What are the dates of the DDD's?

A: February 5th, March 5th, April 9th, and May 7th.

Q: What if the Monday of DDD is a Snow Day?

A: We will have the DDD the following Monday.

Q: What will happen to the clubs and organizations that benefited from MS/HS DDD's?

A: Some of the proceeds from the SCRIP DDD will fund those organizations and clubs as it has been in the past.
